What is included in the price for our weekend in Vienna?

Four nights in a standard double room at the 5-star Grand Ferdinand Hotel. Breakfast is included. You can add nights to your trip when ordering.

There is an extra charge if you want to have the room to yourself – single occupancy.

If you are three or four we recommend that you share a nicely sized luxury-mini-hotel apartment (57 sqm./650 sqft) in the city center as you will save between 800 - 1200 dkk. (£ 90 - 130) per person.

If you want to spend a few more days in Vienna on either side of the event - or upgrade your room – do let us know as we can provide you with extra nights at hotel Grand Ferdinand below the market price.

WEDNESDAY

The following is included in the price: A guided tour of the Palais Coburg's five wine cellars and 55,000 bottles. We will have canapés - and a glass of champagne – the moment we reach the 'champagne cellar'.

Included in the price is a three-course dinner + coffee/tea in their state hall's 'Der Gelbe Raum'. Wine pairing to the dinner is included as well.

(You can 'upgrade' the wines to your heart's desire. In that case, you just pay the price difference).

It is of course possible to have a cognac or similar to the coffee. This is not included in the price.

THURSDAY

Our day-trip takes us to the Esterhazy's castle in Eisenstadt. One of the castle wings is at our disposal. We leave from hotel Ferdinand at about 2 p.m.

The tour, the Haydn concert and wines presented by the castle's sommelier after the concert are included in the price.

Thursday evening: We will have a dinner at a popular and populous restaurant. The menu is included in the price. Drinks excluded.

FRIDAY

We have our very own Hop-On-Hop-Off bus to ourselves this day.

The trip lasts about four hours. Guide and tickets are included in the price.

Friday night: Parnassos has for this evening rented Mozart's house, museum and concert hall.

The tour in the museum, as well as the Mozart concert, is included in the price. Wines and canapés after the concert under Mozart's roof are also included in the price. The event ends at about 9 p.m.

Let's see what the rest of Friday night has to offer. Expenses for this are not included in the price.

SATURDAY

We intend to offer around five guided tours in Vienna for small groups among which you can choose freely. Or simply skip them all together.

Guide plus entrance(s) are included in the price. Feel free to choose two or more events if your time allows for it.

The Danish Radio-presenter, Lotte Heise's Opera lecture at about 17.00 is of course also included in the price.

Saturday night:

We're going to the Vienna State Opera where we will see the opera, Rigoletto by Giuseppe Verdi. Included in the price is a glass of champagne or wine plus a ticket valued at 79 euro. This places us in price category 5 of 9.

If you want to upgrade, you just pay the difference. (This has to be done well in advance of the trip and no later than 1st August).

Let's see what the rest of our Saturday night has to offer. Expenses for this are not included in the price.

SUNDAY

We will drive to Prince Ferdinand's castle near the town of Wachau. It is a trip of a total of 8 hours. The bus, guide, ticket entrance and a 1 ½ hour boat trip on the Danube plus a 2-course lunch, including matching wines, are included in the price.

The following is not included in the price

The return trip to Vienna. It is much cheaper and more flexible if our guests arrange this on their own. An example where 'one size fits all' doesn't fit.

Moreover, if we all take the same flight, we help push up the prices for that particular flight.
