

The trip to Vienna 25th – 29th October 2024

What exactly do you get for your DKK 11,800? (circa 1,575 EUR, £ 1,360).

- 4 nights at the 4* centrally located Hotel Regina – in a shared double room. (you can purchase an additional single room for DKK 2,500/ 335 euro).
- You get a 100-euro voucher for breakfast to use in any café in Vienna.
- If you take the flight with Austrian Airlines, departing from Copenhagen Airport on Friday 25 October at 9.50, a bus will be waiting at Vienna airport and is included in the price.

FRIDAY 25th October 2024

- We visit the six wine cellars in the prestigious Palais Coburg. Guided tour plus wine tasting.
- Private concert at the Bösendorfer hall in Vienna.
- Dinner and wine-pairing at Café Central.

SATURDAY 26th October

- A tour of Vienna, in our own tram with Vienna's tourist director, Gerti Schmidt, as our guide.
- The tram stops at Beethoven's home in Heiligenstadt.
- Guided tour followed by lunch at Beethoven's favorite restaurant nearby. Lunch is included, but not the accompanying drinks.

SUNDAY 27th October

- A bus takes us to Wachau, just outside of Vienna, which stops in an idyllic village where you can enjoy your lunch from a number of charming restaurants. Lunch here is not included in the price.
- In the afternoon we have our champagne reception at Princess Anita von Hohenberg in Artstetten.
- We continue by going to the abbey of Melk, where we will have a guided tour and private organ concert in Stift Melk's church.
- The diocese's lunch restaurant opens for us in the evening. Wine tasting of the monastery's wines and dinner are included in the price. Drinks during the dinner itself, exclusive.

MONDAY 28th October

- The day begins at 2 pm at the enormous Kunsthistorisches Museum.
- At 4.30 pm we visit Stadtpalais Liechtenstein. We will have a guided tour of the Liechtenstein family's private art collection.

- In the evening we preside over the entire Oberes Belvedere. Here, wines and canapés are offered, which are included in the price.
- The evening's event ends with a concert at Belvedere's colossal Ballroom with the quartet, Quartet Vivante.
- After the concert we go to restaurant Salm Bräu with the city's best Wienerschnitzel. Dinner is included in the price. The drinks are between you and the restaurant.

TUESDAY 29th October

For those of you going home on Tuesday, we recommend that you take as late a flight as possible. This gives you time to further exploring the city. Luggage can be stored at the hotel.
